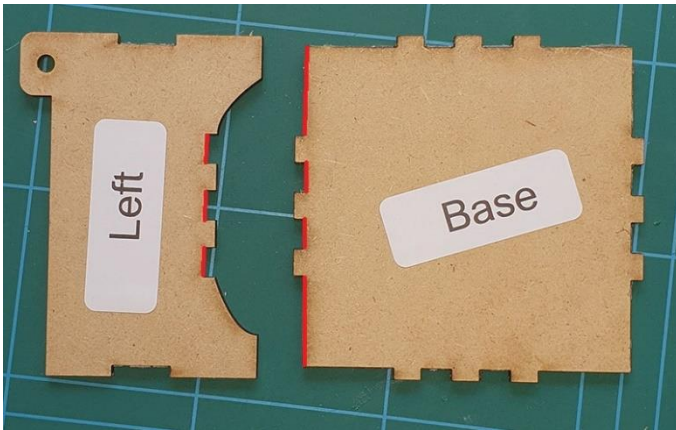
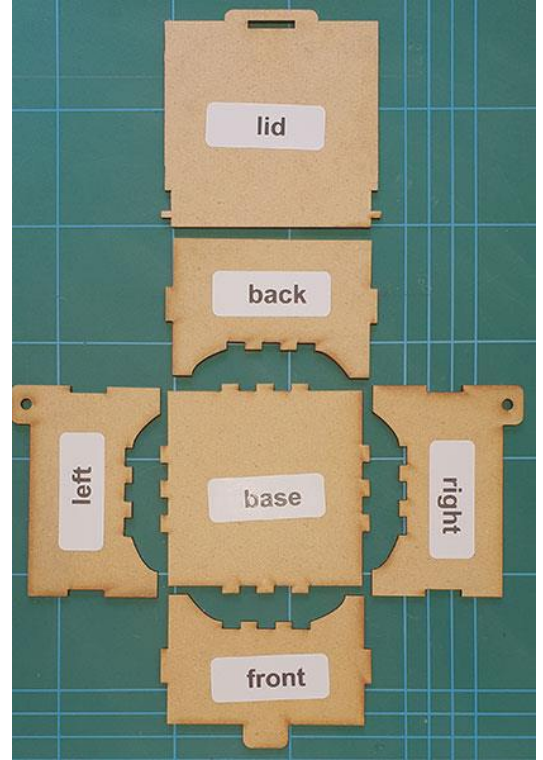


Small box assembly guide

This document is a guide based on my experience of assembling these small boxes. I have used UHU glue, which I find quite runny, and also a good brand of wood glue. Both are pretty good, if you keep the joints tight while setting.

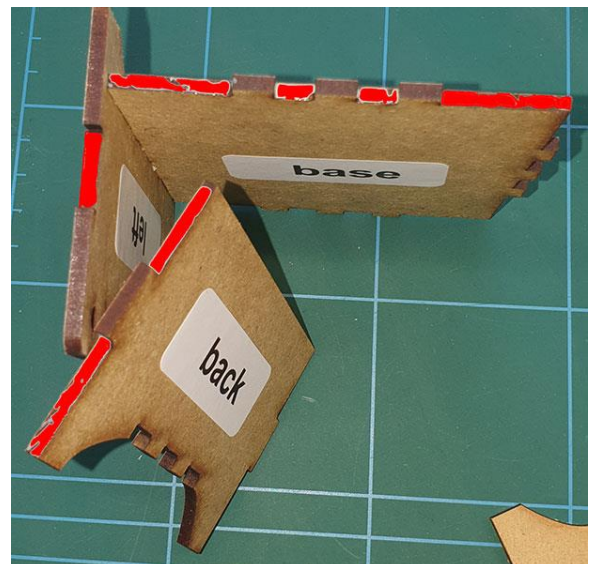
Note! This is a general guide to assembling small boxes, the shape may vary from the pictures slightly, but the process is pretty much the same

Layout all the pieces to ensure correct orientation, try a few pieces dry fit together to see how they fit before gluing. Some of them may be a nice neat fit, and will require a little pressure to join.



Glue the base piece at the locations marked in red, assemble the left piece.

Glue the base, left and back pieces at the locations marked in red.





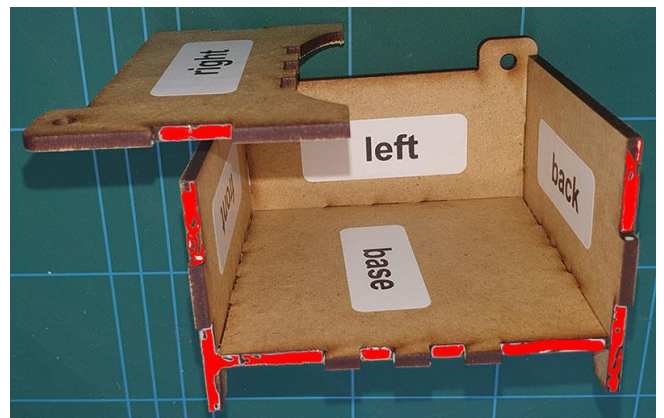
Assemble the back piece to produce the corner.

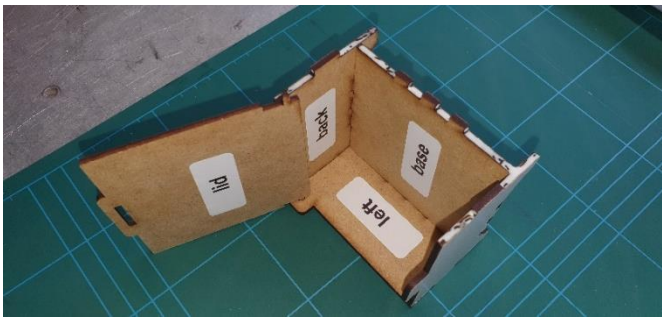
Glue the base, left and front pieces at the locations marked in red.



Assemble the front piece.

Glue the base, front and right pieces at the locations marked in red.





Set the lid piece in position location the small tab in the hole at the corner of the left side. Assemble the right piece into position, ensure you locate the lid tab in the corner hole of the right piece.

I found it helpful to use a couple of elastic bands to hold the joints tight while the glue hardens.



Once the glue has hardened (usually best left overnight) then you can remove the elastic bands and admire your finished creation.
